## **COVID19 SAFE PLAN – 21<sup>st</sup> September 2020**

With reference to advice from the Queensland Bridge Association, the Queensland Department of Health and the Queensland Government's Industry COVID-Safe Plan for Indoor Sports:

We will undertake the following:

1. The Premises will be arranged so that a maximum of 72 people will be able to attend and follow the distancing requirements of 1.5m between people and no more than 1 person per 4sqm inside. Only members of the Sunshine Coast Zone (Caboolture, Bribie Island, Caloundra, Sunshine Coast, Coolum, and Noosa bridge clubs) can attend the playing sessions.
1. Each player, on arrival, must pass the COVID questionnaire test on current health status and recent movements (they will not be admitted if they have been in any government declared "hot spot" in the last 14 days). They will have their temperature tested and asked to use the hand sanitiser provided before entering the club. If they are not a member of the Sunshine Coast bridge club then they must provide contact details for recording for contact tracing purposes.
2. All players are encouraged to have received the 2020 flu vaccine and have downloaded the COVID19 Safe app to their phone.
3. All players must provide their own writing material and water bottle (if required).
4. All players will follow these protocols:
  - a. At the end of each round – use hand sanitiser and wipe the playing surface before moving to the next table
  - b. Ensure the Bridgemates are used by only one person (usually North), checking of scores visually only
5. At the mid-play break players will use the provided disposable cups, individually wrapped sugar sachets and disposable stirring sticks. Milk, if required, will be available in jugs and players are asked to sanitise hands after use. Access to hot water urns to be monitored to ensure social distancing is adhered to. The provided biscuits will be scattered on trays to enable access to individual items to avoid cross-contamination.
6. The dealing of boards to include a wipe down of the outside of the card carrier before distribution
7. Each board will be only used once in every two-week period to minimise frequent board re-use
8. At the end of play, the premises will be thoroughly cleaned including all equipment, tables and chairs that have been used.
