COVID19 SAFE PLAN – 15th April 2022

With reference to advice from the Queensland Bridge Association, the Queensland Department of Health and the Queensland Government's Industry COVID-Safe Plan for Indoor Sports:

We will undertake the following:

1. The Premises will be arranged so that a maximum of 150 people will be able to attend and follow, if possible, the distancing requirements of 1.5m between people and no more than 1 person per 2 sqm inside.
2. Members of Australian bridge clubs, **who meet the vaccination requirements** can attend the playing sessions.
3. Players **must not** attend the clubhouse if they have Covid19-like symptoms. Players experiencing any cold or flu symptoms **should** not attend the clubhouse. The director may ask players who appear unwell to leave.
4. All players are encouraged to have received the **2022** flu vaccine and any recommended Covid booster vaccination(s).
5. All players must provide their own writing material and water bottle (if required).
6. All players will follow these protocols:
 - a. Wear a face mask if you do not feel comfortable inside the clubhouse.
 - b. Use hand sanitiser as necessary for your comfort.
 - c. Use the provided tissues if required.
7. Each set of boards will be only used once every week to minimise frequent board re-use.
